# The Heritage Path Of Vietnam

#### 6 days/ 5 nights

## **Spirit Of The Tour**

This journey takes you to explore the legacies of Vietnam which are classified by UNESCO. During the tour, you will have the opportunity to visit the old town of Hoi An, the archaeological site of My Son and the ancient capital of Hué to better understand Vietnamese culture and history. You'll even have the chance to explore the Paradise Cave, a masterpiece of nature and enjoy mud bath at the Shadow Cave.



## Day 1: Ho Chi Minh City - Da Nang - Hoi An

Pick up at **Da Nang** airport, transfer to visit:

- Visit the Ngu Hanh Son (Marble Mountains), known for its landscape and beauty.
- Discover **Non Nuoc**, famous for marble sculpture making and stone-cutting crafts.
- We continue the journey to **Hoi An**, which was declared UNESCO
  World Cultural Heritage because of
  its ancient town. It is an
  exceptionally well-preserved
  example of a South-East Asian





Lunch. Walk in the center of the old town and visit typical old houses in **Hoi An**, the **Chua Cau** bridge (Japanese Covered Bridge) and the **Quan Cong Temple**.

Dinner. Overnight at hotel.

## Day 2: Hoi An - My Son - Hoi An

Departure towards the archaeological site of **My Son**, UNESCO World Heritage. Discover the ruins of the capital of the ancient **Champa kingdom**. Enjoy a dance performance. Lunch. We take the road to the port for a boat ride of one hour on the **Thu Bon River**, then we arrive in the carpentry village **Kim Bong**. Biking around the village and take an over look of the carpentry craft workshops.



After one and a half hours in the carpentry

village, we get back on the boat to navigate to the pottery village **Thanh Ha**. We walk through the village and study pottery techniques by the local craftsmen. Possibility of manufacturing a cup or a traditional terracotta game by yourself. Return to the hotel by bicycle.

Dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight at the hotel.

### Day 3: Hoi An - Hué

In the morning we depart for **Hué** (4 hours). Check in hotel.

Lunch. We continue to visit

- The Imperial City and the Purple Forbidden City of the Nguyen Dynasty, famous historical relics in Vietnam.
- We continue to enjoy the beautiful views along the **Perfume River.**
- The Pagoda of the Celestial



**Lady**, the highest pagoda in Vietnam, one of the major symbols of the city. Dinner. Cruise trip on the **Perfume River** listening to **Nha Nhac Cung Dinh Hue**, a type of traditional court music singing of the Nguyen dynasty. Overnight at the hotel.

## Day 4: Hue - Dong Hoi

A new day to understand history and sculture by visiting the **tomb of Tu Duc**, one of the most famous kings of the Nguyen kingdom. This tomb is the most spacious as well as the most beautiful of the Nguyen kings tombs. The **tomb of Khai Dinh** is the next destination, especially the mix of different architectures between Eastern and Western styles of the tomb appeals to all visitors. Lunch. We transfer to **Dong Hoi** (3



hours). Check In at the hotel. Dinner. Overnight at the hotel.

# Day 5 : Dong Hoi – Paradise Cave – Shadow Cave

Departure for the **Paradise cave** in the heart of the **Phong Nha - Ke Bang park**. It's the longest dry cave in Asia which was discovered by UK explorers in 2005. The Paradise cave is considered one of the world's top natural wonders, it is also called "underground palace". We continue to the **Shadow cave**, a branch of the **Phong Nha cave system**.



Lunch. To explore the **Shadow cave**, you are equipped with a head light and specific equipment to explore the system of rivers underground and admiring thousands of stalactites and stalagmites of all sizes. You have the opportunity to take a zip line to cross the **Chay river**. Explore the cave and later enjoy a 100% pure and natural mud bath. We return to the starting point in kayak and participate in other water activities. Return to **Dong Hoi**. Dinner. Overnight at the hotel.

## Day 6: Dong Hoi – Ho Chi Minh City

Departure to the **Dong Hoi airport** for the flight back to **Ho Chi Minh City**. End of tour.

#### The price of the tour includes:
